Abstract

The current research aims to identify:

- 1 Motivation of friendliness among university students.
- 2 Significance of differences in friendliness motivation among university students according to the variables (male-female) and academic specialization (scientific –human).
- 3 Spiritual intelligence among university students.
- 4 Significance of differences in spiritual intelligence among university students according to the variables (male female) and academic specialization (scientific human) .
- 5 –Figuring out the correlation between the motivation of friendliness and spiritual intelligence among university students.
- 6 Significance of differences in the correlation between intimacy motivation and spiritual intelligence according to the variable (male-female) and academic specialization (scientific-human).

The researcher identified the current research community with students from the University of Maysan/ morning study for the academic year (2022_2023), whose number is (13371), with (5784) male and female students from scientific disciplines and (7587) male and female students from humanities. Besides, the research sample included (400) male and female students from University of Maysan and a scale, consisting of (28) items, the motivation of children was prepared by the measuring researcher . After reviewing the literature and previous studies, the researcher adopted the scale of (Al-Taie, 2016) on spiritual intelligence, consisting of (24) items, and the psychometric characteristics of face validity and indicators of construct validity were found. Moreover, find consistency by two methods (test and re-test, and alpha Cronbah) then the data were analyzed statistically using the Statistical Package for the Social Sciences (SPSS), and the results showed the following:

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- 1- University students enjoy a good amount of friendliness motivation, which helps them to establish friendly relationships with other individuals, if the calculated t-value (18,624) is greater than the tabular t-value (1.96) at the level of significance of (0.05).
- 2 There are statistically significant differences among university students according to variable (male, female) and in favor of males, if the calculated t-value (2,177) is greater than the tabular t-value (1.96) at the level of significance of (0.05), and there are no statically significant differences according to the variable of specialization (scientific, human).
- 3 The university students have a good level of spiritual intelligence if the calculated t-value (9,591) is greater than the tabular t-value (1.96) at the significance level of (0.05).
- 4 There are statistically significant differences among university students according variable (male, female) and in favor of females, if the calculated t-value (_4,609) is greater than the tabular t-value (1.96) at the level of significance of (0.05), and there are no statistically significant differences according to the variable of specialization (scientific, human).
- 5 There is a positive correlation between the two research variables, the motivation of friendliness and the spiritual intelligence of university students.
- 6 There are no statistically significant differences between friendliness motivation and spiritual intelligence according to the variable(male,female)andspecialization (scientific, human).

In light of the results, the researcher developed a set of conclusions, recommendations and suggestions.
